In order to reduce the risk of community spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19), the City of San Dimas is announcing temporary precautionary changes to City operations to protect city employees and the general public. As we continue to work together to confront the impact of COVID-19, **the City of San Dimas City Hall, and all other city facilities will be closed to the public, effective tomorrow, March 17, 2020, until further notice.**

City operations will continue to run with staff available to provide services and answer questions by phone and by email during regular business hours.
