Latest Updates:

- Bulky item pick-up reminder: if you scheduled a bulky item pick-up, please remember, **you can only place the item(s) out for pick-up at the curbside or in the alley AFTER 6 PM on MONDAY**
- Governor Gavin Newsom launched California Connected, the state's comprehensive contact tracing program and public awareness campaign
 - As part of California Connected, public health workers from communities across the state will connect with individuals who test positive for COVID-19 and work with them, and people they have been in close contact with, to ensure they have access to confidential testing, as well as medical care and other services to help prevent the spread of the virus
 - Public health authorities will not share information with outside entities. Information will be used for public health purposes only. Contact tracers will not ask for financial information, social security numbers or immigration status
