Latest Updates:

- Los Angeles County will provide 3 home-delivered meals a day, through the Great Plates program, to qualifying older adults and adults over 60 who are high-risk as determined by the CDC. To see if you qualify, visit <https://wdacs.lacounty.gov/greatplates>. Call 2-1-1 to apply!
- Select DMV offices are NOW OPEN! For a list of the open offices and the limited services provided, visit: https://www.dmv.ca.gov/portal/dmv/detail/pubs/newsrel/2020/2020_19. As a reminder you will be required to wear a face covering when entering a DMV office
- For those returning to work, it is important to follow the protocols that are issued from Los Angeles County. Please continue to practice and ensure physical distancing, wear a cloth face covering, and wash or sanitize your hands often
- Recognizing the threat COVID-19 continues to pose to public health, Governor Gavin Newsom today signed an executive order to ensure that Californians can exercise their right to vote in a safe and accessible manner during the General Election this November
 - The order requires that each county's elections officials send vote-by-mail ballots for the November 3, 2020 General Election to all registered voters
 - Californians who may need access to in-person voting opportunities – including individuals with disabilities, individuals who speak languages other than English, individuals experiencing homelessness, and others – will still be able to access in-person voting opportunities
