#07-20-01 WEST 4th ST/NORTH EUCLA AVE INTERSECTION

REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of Stop sign on 4th Street at this intersection to match the stop sign placement for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 5th streets to circumvent potential collisions.

#07-20-02 SAN DIMAS AVE AT AVENIDA LOMA VISTA AND TRAIL CROSSING

REQUEST FROM STAFF, to review proposed striping for Avenida Loma Vista and proposed trail exhibit signage for San Dimas Ave.

#07-20-03 AVENIDA LOMA VISTA AND PASEO GRACIA

REQUEST FROM RESIDENTS, to review and consider enhancements to alleviate the excessive parking on Avenida Loma Vista and Paseo Gracia on weekends. The patrons of the Antonovich Trail are leaving trash and debris on their streets. Residents suggest permit parking for residents or perhaps provided limited free passes to walk the trail (similar to Eaton Canyon).
