Latest Updates:

- Applications are now open for the second round of COVID-19 recovery grants
 - The regional fund will offer loan and grant resources to micro-entrepreneurs, small businesses, and non-profits

- Bonita School District families can submit their 2020-21 meal applications today. Households can apply for free or reduced-priced meals at <http://do.bonita.k12.ca.us/>. Applications can be completed online with your smartphone, tablet, or computer
- Governor Newsom released new guidelines today for barbershops and hair salons to operate outdoors in a safe environment
 - The State of California COVID-19 website provides guidelines for hair salons and barbershops to support a safe, clean, outdoor environment for workers and customers. Hair salon or barbershop owners must acknowledge that lessees should only resume operations when they are ready and able to implement the necessary safety measures to provide for their safety and that of their customers
- Public Health has a dedicated call line for confirmed cases of COVID-19. If you have not yet connected with a public health specialist or need more information on services, call toll-free at 1-833-540-0473. Additionally, they have taken the following new steps to encourage more cooperation with their case investigation and contact tracing efforts:
 - Providing resources for community-based organizations to assist with communications, navigation, case management, and connections to resources for isolation and quarantine. LA County Public Health has allocated \$10 million to support these efforts and both the DHS and the City of Los Angeles are allocating additional resources to ensure residents are connected to services and support should they need to isolate or quarantine
 - Piloting the offering of \$20 gift cards as an incentive for full participation in the interview process
 - Promoting a call center that people with a positive lab result for COVID-19 can call to complete a case interview and connect to resources
 - This week they will be launching a new text messaging system to track contacts during their 14 days of quarantine to make sure they are okay
