- Due to sustained high temperatures, the San Dimas Senior Center/Community Center (201 E. Bonita Avenue) will be operational as a cooling center location tomorrow, Saturday, August 1 from 10 am - 6 pm. If you plan on attending, please be considerate of others and wear a mask at all times. State and local social distancing guidelines will be strictly enforced
