Latest Updates:

- The Los Angeles County Health Officer released a Revised County Health Order on August 12, 2020. To view the Health Order click here, "[Reopening Safer at Work and in The Community for Control of COVID-19 – Moving The County of Los Angeles Into Stage 3 of California Pandemic Resilience Roadmap](#)" Updates include:
 - Clarifying when elementary schools may seek a waiver to conduct in-person instruction in elementary schools for grades TK-6.
 - Updating operations to childcare facilities to specify childcare must be carried out in stable groups of 12 or fewer children in the same group each day, instead of 10.
 - Aligning with new guidance for Institutes of Higher Education.
 - Updating revision dates on last page, "Appendices at a Glance."
