Latest Updates:

Local:

- The Foothill Gold Line crews will be receiving a shipment of rail sticks tomorrow, September 2, and Thursday, September 3, from 7 am – 4 pm. During these times, Railway Crossing interruptions will occur from Lone Hill Avenue to Gladstone/Eucla Avenue on Wednesday/Thursday and Bonita/Cataract and Walnut Avenue on Thursday
 - On Wednesday, Eucla crossing will be closed five times for approximately 3 – 5 minutes each time the train crosses through the grade crossing
 - On Thursday Eucla crossing will be closed an additional 1 - 4 times for about 3 – 5 minutes each time the train crosses through the grade crossing
 - On Thursday Bonita/Cataract and Walnut Avenue crossings will be closed two times for approximately 3 – 5 minutes each time the train crosses through the grade crossing
 - Per the FRA (Federal Railroad Administration), the horn will need to be blown as the train comes through the crossings
