Latest Updates:

Local:

- Bobcat Fire update: for the safety of everyone, the temporary forest closure of the Angeles National Forest System lands has been extended through Thursday, October 1. As of this morning, the Bobcat Fire is approximately 113,307 acres with 38% containment. There is currently 1,556 personnel assigned to the incident. Last night crews completed the strategic firing operation north from Mt. Wilson to Highway 2 and the east to the fire perimeter

County:

- According to the State's Blueprint for a Safer Economy, Los Angeles County has met the metric thresholds for Tier 2 (Substantial risk level). Per the State guidelines, Los Angeles County must continue to meet these metric thresholds for two consecutive weeks before moving into Tier 2
 - The State also announced that counties may now make their determination to allow nail salons to resume indoor operations
 - Public Health will be consulting with the Board of Supervisors to determine the timing of adopting changes to the County Health Officer Order that would allow nail salons to resume modified indoor operations

State:

- Governor Gavin Newsom today announced that he would aggressively move the State further away from its reliance on climate change-causing fossil fuels while retaining and creating jobs and spurring economic growth – he issued an executive order requiring sales of all new passenger vehicles to be zero-emission by 2035 and additional measures to eliminate harmful emissions from the transportation sector
