##### *County:*

- The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health has updated the Health Order to reflect the allowing of private gatherings of no more 3 households, but only in compliance with the requirements below. To view the Health Order visit, <http://publichealth.lacounty.gov/media/Coronavirus/>
  - Private gatherings cannot exceed more than 3 households
  - Private gatherings must be held outdoors
  - Attendees must be wearing a face covering when not eating or drinking
  - Everyone must follow the Social Distancing Protocol
  - Food if served, must be in single serve disposable containers
  - The duration of the gathering to should be limited to two hours or less
  - Anyone who develops COVID-19 within 48 hours after attending a gathering must notify the Department of Public Health at (888) 397-3993 or (213) 240-7821 and should notify the other attendees
