**#11-20-01 145 W COMMERCIAL**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of blue curb on east side of Monte Vista north of West Commercial St as authorized by SDMC 10.24.096.*

**#11-20-02 SAN DIMAS AVE / BASELINE RD INTERSECTION**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of flashing crosswalk and signage for this large intersection similar to downtown Bonita flashing crosswalks. Per resident it is perceived vehicles are speeding and ignoring pedestrians crossing the intersection. Per resident pedestrians have had too many close calls.*

**#11-20-03 MAVERICK DR.**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider improvements to gate at Horsethief Canyon Park entrance. Per resident second time a vehicle drives through the locked gates at the end of Maverick and the concern is flying gates could harm pedestrians walking.*

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider relocation of red zones and bus stop to allow senior / disabled residents from mobile home park to park closer to entrance.*

**#11-20-05 1335 CYPRESS ST.**

*REQUEST FROM BUSINESS, to review and consider removal of portion of curb at the entrance to Medical Arts Building of San Dimas. Said curb is causing customers of business to pop tires semi regularly upon entrance to parking lot. Per Management building contractor advised that City requested the curb configuration.*

**#11-20-06 PUDDINGSTONE DR. AND SAN DIMAS AVE.**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of signage to assist the crossing for coyotes. Resident suggests signs approximately 100' south of Puddingstone/San Dimas intersection and additional sign north of Puddingstone/San Dimas intersection closer to W. Via Vaquero. Resident believes until real solution for coyotes is found, warning signs for motorist will assist them in this area.*

**#09-20-02 WILD ROSE LANE**

*REQUEST FROM HOA, to review and consider reducing speed limit to 10mph due to special circumstances of this short, narrow, curvy road. Motorist are driving too fast in this area and almost striking the pedestrians. Additionally, it is perceived motorists are using Wild Rose Lane to by-pass the Foothill/Amelia traffic signal.*
