##### *State:*

- Governor Newsom and the California Department of Public Health announced a [Limited Stay at Home Order](#). This Order requires non-essential work, movement and gatherings stop between 10 pm – 5 am in counties in the purple tier. The order will take effect Saturday, November 21, 2020 at 10 pm - 5 am Monday, December 21. Los Angeles County along with many other counties are in the purple tier.
