### City of San Dimas Office of the City Manager – Update November 7, 2020

#### *Latest Updates:*

#### *Local:*

- Day 2 of 12 Days of San Dimas is tomorrow! Finish up your Christmas shopping and support local businesses! Check out the map provided by San Dimas Chamber of Commerce for all deals: <https://maphub.net/CityofSanDimas/12-days-of-san-dimas-event>

#### *County:*

- The restaurant grant application is now open. Applications are now open through December 8, 2020 5:00 pm or until 2,500 applications received. Apply now at [Keep LA County Dining \(lacda.org\)](http://KeepLACountyDining.lacda.org).

#### *State:*

- The Southern California Region ICU capacity was 10.9%, which triggered the Regional Stay-At-Home Order. The [State Regional Stay-At-Home Order](#) went into effect for Southern California on Sunday, December 6 at 11:59 pm and will continue until December 27, 2020. This order prohibits gatherings with anyone not in your own household members. It requires 100% masking and physical distancing whenever individuals are outside their home.
- The Regional Stay at Home Order requires the following sectors to close or remain closed:
  - Bars, Wineries, Breweries, and Distilleries
  - Personal Care Services, Hair Salons and Barbershops
  - Indoor and Outdoor Playgrounds
  - Indoor recreation facilities
  - Museums, zoos, and aquariums
  - Movie theaters, Family entertainment centers
  - Cardrooms and satellite wagering
  - Limited services as defined by the state
  - Live audience sports and Amusement parks
- Sectors that will remain open have additional modifications in addition to 100% masking and physical distancing include:
  - Schools that have received a waiver
  - Critical infrastructure
  - Retail (20% capacity to reduce exposure)
  - Restaurants (take-out, pick-up and delivery)
  - Outdoor recreational facilities are allowed only without any food, drink or alcohol sales. Additionally, overnight stays for recreational visits at campgrounds will not be permitted.
  - Hotels and lodging are allowed to open for critical infrastructure support only.
  - Offices are allowed as remote only except for critical infrastructure sectors where remote working is not possible.
  - Places of worship and political expression are allowed outdoor services only.
- Governor Newsom announced that Google and Apple headquarters have joined together to create participate in exposure notifications. The CA Notify Application is not contact tracing and is completely voluntary. CA Notify is 100% private, secure and no tracking data is shared.
