**#05-21-02 ALLEN AVE AT CHAPPARAL RD**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review perceived speeding on Allen Ave. Request for review and consideration of installation of stop sign at Chapparral Rd to slow down speeding vehicles on Allen Ave.*
