This assistance is designed to help individuals and families at risk of homelessness. Applicants will be required to provide documentation of their hardship and meet the program criteria.	Emergency grants may be used to assist with rent payments, utility payments or groceries. Landlords can choose to accept/deny 80% of unpaid rent . If a landlord accepts this funding, they agree to forgive the remaining unpaid rent for that covered period. If landlord does not accept, tenant may still qualify for 25% of unpaid rent to be paid. Eligible renters may also receive assistance with future rent, unpaid/future utility payments.
