### **#06-21-01 AVENIDA ENTRADA**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review perceived speeding and provide mitigation and additional enforcement of speeding.*

### **#06-21-02 AVENIDA LOMA VISTA / CALLE VISTASO**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review perceived speeding on Avenida Loma Vista and consider installation of speed bumps leading up to each Stop sign to slow down drivers.*

### **#06-21-03 AVENIDA LOMA VISTA / PASEO GRACIA**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review and consider installation of No U-turn signage for this area to deter the increase in vehicles turning around on Paseo Gracia.*

### **#06-21-04 RAILWAY ST**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review perceived speeding on Railway St and consider installation of speed humps to slow down drivers.*

### **#06-21-05 RAILWAY ST AND CATARACT AVE**

*REQUEST FROM RESIDENT, to review intersection as concerns are for merging vehicles onto Cataract Ave from Railway St. Per resident, vehicles travel at high speeds on Cataract Ave and parked cars on Cataract Ave can also present a line of sight issue when cars are pulling out of Railway St. Additionally, resident feels the heavy pedestrian traffic from Pioneer Park increases the dangers for this intersection.*
